- WHY : to secure Europe's interests and establish its role in the Future Internet domain.
- HOW:

  - Make it an application driven PPP

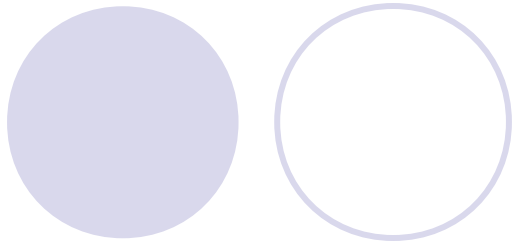

**an industrial, economic and societal success.**

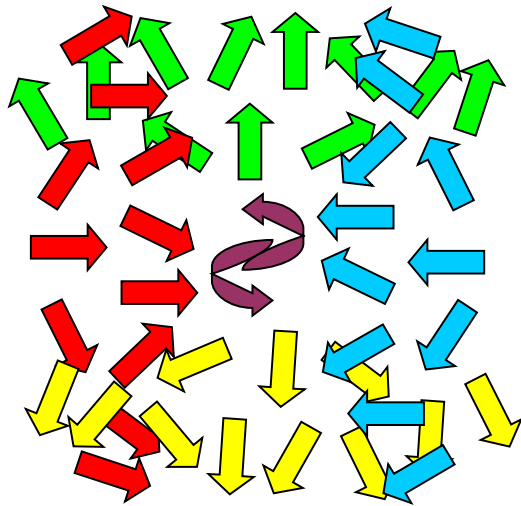

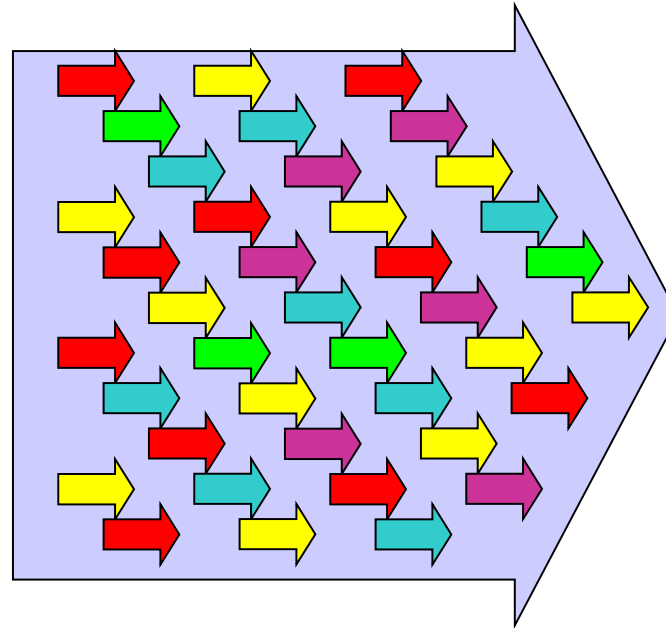
# Cross Sector and Sustainable

- Stand alone solutions developed in any one sector, will not provide the efficiency and productivity gains that a networked solution will be able to provide and that the market can support.
- A multidisciplinary approach, where massively distributed services and applications are run over large scale internet infrastructures is the only means to deal with the increasing complexity of intertwined application and service requirements.
- Only strong coordinated and decisive action can enable the establishment of such a multidisciplinary approach at the European level.
